In an effort to level the playing field for scientists involved in important research, but who may lack the funding to pay for publication of their work, *The Journal of Chemical Physics* (JCP) will eliminate all page charges beginning on 1 January 2008; any manuscript bearing an online publication date of 1 January 2008 or later will fall under this new policy.
