

Announcement: Reduced fees for color in print

In a continuing effort to minimize costs to authors, the American Institute of Physics is reducing the fee for color figures in print. As of the first published issue of 2009, authors who choose to have color illustrations in the printed journal will be assessed a color-printing fee of US\$325 for each color figure. For multipart color figures, a single charge will apply only if all parts are submitted as a single piece of artwork. This new reduced rate eliminates the surcharge previously placed on the first color figure printed in the published paper.

Following our long-standing practice, color in the online version of the journal remains free of charge to authors.
