**Publication charge:** The American Institute of Physics does not require page charges for this journal.

**Color Printing:** Color illustrations will be published free of charge to authors if the Journal's editors deem the use of color to be essential. For all other color figures, fixed rates of \$650 for the first color figure and \$325 for each additional color figure apply. For multipart figures, a single charge will apply only if all parts are submitted as a single piece of artwork.
