**Publication Charge:** Although the journal carries no regular page charge, for any contributed published article that exceeds 12 journal pages, a mandatory \$150 page charge will be added for each page in excess of 12 pages.

For all other color figures, fixed rates of \$650 for the first color figure and \$325 for each additional color figure apply.
