SPECIAL ISSUE ON: Selected papers from the 11th International Conference on Source Code Analysis and Manipulation (SCAM 2011)

The proposed IET Software special issue will consist of selected best papers that appeared at the Eleventh IEEE Working Conference on Source Code Analysis and Manipulation, Williamsburg, Virginia, USA, 2011. The special issue will be edited by Árpád Beszédés and Dawn Lawrie.

SCAM 2011 is focused on the field of source code analysis and manipulation. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- program transformation
- abstract interpretation
- program slicing
- source level software metrics
- decompilation
- source level testing and verification
- source level optimization
- program comprehension

In particular SCAM is interested in results from any theoretical or technological domain that can be applied to these and similar topics. In addition, SCAM is focused on tools for source code analysis and manipulation.

The SCAM 2011 program chairs invite 7 best papers to be submitted for review and publication by the IET journal. Authors of selected papers from the Conference are invited to submit extended versions for full re-review. The extended version should be non-trivially extended from the version that has appeared in the Conference Proceedings. As a rough guide, authors should ensure that the extended paper contains, at a very minimum 30% new material. The authors should write a brief note to accompany their submission that explains the manner in which the extended version of the paper does, indeed, constitute an extension of the original version, pointing out, for example, areas where new text or results have been included, where text has been re-written and where extra depth is provided.
