The Journal of Chemical Physics is published four times per month, 48 issues per year by the American Institute of Physics (AIP). The purpose of *The Journal of Chemical Physics* is to bridge a gap between journals of physics and journals of chemistry. The artificial boundary between physics and chemistry has now been in actual fact completely eliminated, and a large and active group is engaged in research which is as much the one as the other. It is to this group that the Journal is rendering its principal service and makes its greatest appeal, both as a prompt and efficient medium for publication of research and as a convenient and carefully edited assemblage of pertinent information.

Publication Charge: To support the cost of wide dissemination of research results through publication of journal pages and production of a database of articles, the author's institution is requested to pay a page charge of \$55 per page (with a one-page minimum) and an *article charge* of \$20 per article. For any regular, published article that exceeds 12 journal pages, a mandatory \$150 page charge will be added for each page in excess of 12 pages. For Errata the minimum page charge is \$10, with no article charge.
