Information for Authors

Submissions: Submit manuscripts (2 copies) to Donald Levy, Editor, *The Journal of Chemical Physics*, Department of Chemistry, 5735 S. Publication Charge: To support the cost of wide dissemination of research results through publication of journal pages and production of a database of articles, the author's institution is requested to pay a page charge of \$55 per page (with a one-page minimum) and an *article charge* of \$20 per article. For any regular, published article that exceeds 12 journal pages, a mandatory \$150 page charge will be added for each page in excess of 12 pages. For Errata the minimum page charge is \$10, with no article charge.

Reprints: Reprints can be ordered with or without covers only in multiples of 50 (with a minimum of 100 in each category) from AIP, Circulation & Fulfillment/Reprints, 500 Sunnyside Blvd., Woodbury, NY 11797-2999; Fax: 516-349-9704; Telephone: 800-344-6909 (U.S. and Canada), or 516-576-2234.
