Publication Charge: Although the journal carries no regular page charge, for any regular published article that exceeds 10 journal pages, a mandatory \$150 page charge will be added for each page in excess of 10 pages.

Free Color Online: If authors supply usable color graphics files in time for the production process, color will appear in the online journal free of charge. Authors or their institutions must bear the cost of any color they wish to use in print. A fixed rate of \$650 for the first color figure and \$325 for each additional color figure applies for color in print. For multipart figures, a single charge will apply only if all parts are submitted as a single piece of artwork.
